Shakopee, MN -- Meter Me a Lady was declared the winner of the \$21,500 Minnesota Stallion Breeders' Quarter Horse Futurity on Sunday at Canterbury Park after the favorite Courtney Kansas was disqualified for interference shortly after leaving the starting gate.

Meter Me a Lady, a 2-year-old filly, was ridden by Clyde Smith. She is trained by Robert Johnson and owned by John Johnson of Lemmon, South Dakota. She returned \$17.40 to win.

Courtney Kansas completed the 350 yards in 18.15 seconds but placed ninth by the board of stewards following the disqualification. Whiz Happens was moved from third to second and My Morning Light from fourth to third.
