- Horses must be tattooed (TRPB).
- No substitutions without prior approval.
- No more than 54 stalls will be allocated to any one trainer.
- Stalls will not be approved without current racing records or significant work patterns.
- All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by a health certificate issued with the past 10 days and a negative Coggins test issued within the last 12 months prior to September 14, 2013. Horses with a health certificate originating from a state with recorded active cases of Equine Piroplasmosis (EP) must have a negative test for Babesia (Theileria) equi and Babesia caballi taken in the calendar year prior to September 14, 2013. Canterbury Park Holding Corporation Terms and Conditions

The undersigned trainer ("Trainer") and Canterbury Park ("Canterbury") hereby agree to each of the following terms and consideration for permission of Canterbury for the stabling, trainer or racing of horses by the Trainer and Canterbury, before, during and following the race meet identified on this application. This is not a lease for space, but is merely a revocable permit on the terms outlined.

Screening Rules

- 1. No horse age 14 years of age or older is eligible.
- 2. Stalls will not be assigned and reserved in the name of individual thoroughbreds or quarter horses. Trainers wishing to make a substitution from their list of approved horses must receive permission from Racing Secretary Doug Schoepf prior to arrival. Do not ship horses not on your approved list.
- 3. Stall applications that are balanced and demonstrate readiness to race will receive priority consideration. In addition, starts per stall of the Trainer and other statistics may be used in consideration of stall applications.
- 4. Filing this application does not guarantee stall space. Do not ship horses without approval from the stall committee.
- 5. Pony stalls will be allotted based on stable size. A pony stall is not guaranteed.
- 6. Per an agreement between Canterbury and the Minnesota H.B.P.A., no single trainer may have more than 54 stalls.

General Rules

- All stable reservations and entries in stakes and all other races which are received and accepted are subject to all conditions, rules and regulations of the Minnesota Racing Commission and Canterbury.
- 2. Canterbury reserves the right to refuse this application for stable space in whole or in part or the entry or the acceptance of a transfer of an entry for any cause and without notice to the subscriber.
- 3. After the submission of the application, the Trainer shall notify Racing Secretary Doug Schoepf immediately of any change in stall requirements and/or any change in shipping plans.
- 4. All owners, trainers, jockeys and stable employees must be licensed by the Minnesota Racing Commission.
- 5. All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by a health certificate issued with the past 10 days and a negative Coggins Test Certificate issued within the last 12 months prior to September 14, 2013. Horses with a health certificate originating from a state with recorded active cases of Equine Piroplasmosis (EP) must have a negative test for Babesia (Theileria) equi and Babesia caballi taken in the calendar year prior to September 14, 2013. Visit www.mrc.state.us for additional info.
- 6. It is strongly recommended that all horses be vaccinated against EHV1 and strangles before entering the grounds.
- 7. Medication thresholds utilized by the Minnesota Racing Commission are available in the Condition Book and on the Minnesota Racing Commission website.
- 8. No dogs will be allowed overnight in the stable area and dogs are forbidden from Canterbury's dormitories.
- 9. Each owner and trainer is responsible for damage done to the physical property of the stables they occupy.
- 10. Horses claimed by, or transferred, or sold to any person or stable which is not registered for racing at Canterbury must be removed from the grounds within 24 hours after they are claimed, transferred or sold unless their continued presence has been approved by Canterbury.
- 11. The Trainer represents that he/she is familiar with and has read the rules of racing and the regulations of the Minnesota Racing Commission and all conditions applicable to the racing meet identified herein as well as the rules and regulations of Canterbury and agrees to be bound by and comply with the same. Canterbury will not promulgate any rules or regulations contrary to those stated herein. All stable reservations and entries in stakes and all other races shall be subject to all conditions, rules and regulations of the Minnesota Racing Commission and Canterbury.
- 12. All disputes, claims and objections arising out of the rules of racing or with respect to the interpretation of any rule or the conditions of racing or otherwise shall be decided by the Stewards of the meeting or the Minnesota Racing Commission subject to all legal rights of appeal. Trainer agrees to accept and abide all decisions of such officials pertaining to the presence or the conduct of the Trainer or the Trainer's employees on the premises of Canterbury.
- 13. The Trainer represents that he/she has the right to make all the representations, promises, consents, indemnities and release given in this application on behalf of every owner of every horse listed on this application, and that each such owner of every horse listed on this application (in addition to the undersigned) is bound thereby to the same extent as though such owner had also signed this application. Wherever this application refers to the undersigned or to the horses, equipment, agents or employees of the undersigned, it includes said owners and the horses, equipment, agents and employees of each said owner.

Worker's Compensation

1. Any Trainer racing at Canterbury is required to have a valid certificate of insurance for worker's compensation.

T.R.P.B Investigative Release

1. In making this application to participate in thoroughbred and/or quarter horse racing, it is understood that an investigative report may be made whereby information is obtained through personal interviews with third parties (such as family members, business associates, financial sources, neighbors or others with whom the Trainer is acquainted). This inquiry includes information as to the Trainer's character, general representation, personal characteristics and mode of living - which may be applicable. The Trainer has the right to make written requests within a reasonable period of time for a complete and accurate disclosure of additional information concerning the nature and scope of the investigation.

Code of Conduct

1. Canterbury Park requires its participants to adhere to its anti-slaughter policy. Any owner or trainer stabled at Canterbury who knowingly, or without conducting proper due diligence, sells a horse for slaughter, directly or indirectly, will have his/her stalls permanently revoked from Canterbury. Canterbury requires its owners and trainers to conduct due diligence on those buying horses and encourages its owners and trainers to support rescue and adoption efforts and to find humane ways of dealing with horses unable to continue racing. By signing this stall application, the Trainer agrees to be bound by, and notify all his/her owners of, Canterbury Park's anti-slaughter policy as stated herein.

Release

- 1. Canterbury makes no representation or warranty as to the condition, use or operation of stable facilities and occupancy of such facilities by Trainer, and his or her horses and employees shall conclusively establish that such facilities are in satisfactory and acceptable condition, order and repair. Canterbury will in no event be considered to have responsibility for the care, custody or control of horses kept at the track or elsewhere. Trainer assumes full responsibility for the safety and well-being of all horses stabled at the track. Trainer agrees to take all reasonable measures for the protection of such horses including providing adequate supervision for such animals while on the premises, hiring competent personnel to care for such animals at all times, cleaning and maintaining stalls assigned pursuant to this application, and removing any hazardous condition from such stalls which is known to Trainer or employees. If Trainer believes that a hazardous condition should be remedied by Canterbury, Trainer shall promptly call to the attention of Canterbury any such hazardous condition. Trainer further agrees to properly supervise all employees and agents. Trainer hereby acknowledges responsibility for the conduct of employees and agents, and that Canterbury has no obligation to remedy any condition on the track premises which may be caused by the negligence or willful conduct of any such employees or agents unless Canterbury has prior notice of the existence of such condition and has had a reasonable opportunity to repair such condition. Stalls occupied by horses must be unlocked at all times. Tack rooms must be unlocked when occupied.
- Canterbury may desire to televise and/or record (audio and video) certain images and sounds of the races and activities incident to them and to broadcast, exhibit and/or exploit the same by any means now or hereafter known. Is reserves all rights in connection, therewith.
