Brad Berman Wins \$74,901 in Fall Poker Classic Main Event

Shakopee, MN -- Brad Berman of Deephaven, MN won the \$74,901 first prize in the championship event of Canterbury Park's ninth annual Fall Poker Classic. Berman, 38, was one of 234 players paying a \$1,000 entry fee to compete in the two-day No-Limit Hold'em Championship on Oct. 22-23. The Fall Poker Classic is the Canterbury Card Club's signature tournament spanning 14 days and offering 15 individual events. This year there were a total of 3,120 entries in the various Fall Poker Classic events with \$924,889 in prize money.

Berman, a veteran poker player with a national reputation, also won the Fall Poker Classic No-Limit Hold'em Championship in 2006. He is the son of Lyle Berman, the man who earlier this decade brought poker to the forefront of the American consciousness through the televised World Poker Tour.

The Canterbury Card Club, located in Shakopee, MN, is open year round, dealing a variety of games 24 hours a day, including Hold'em, Seven-Card Stud and Blackjack.
