Event plays 8-handed. Final table starts 9 handed. This is a 1-day tournament and plays until completion. Event plays on Track Level.

11 AM Start: Registration opens at 9 AM. Players must register with their MVP Rewards card at the Cashier Cage.

Late registration and unlimited re-entry available through the break after level 8 (approx. 3:30 PM).

All pre-registered player's chip stacks will be in play at the start. All late entries/re-entry receive a full chip stack and must be checked in to their table by the start of level 9.

15 minute break every 4 levels. 40 minute break when the final table of 9 is reached.

Breaks may be adjusted at Tournament Director discretion.
